

#### LIEUTENANT GENERAL

#### BLACKSHEAR MORRISON BRYAN. USA

Blackshear Morrison Bryan was born in Alexandria, Louisiana, February 8, 1900. He attended Virginia Hilitary Institute and then entered the U. S. Military Academy in November 1918. He was graduated and commissioned a second lioutonant of Field Artillory on June 14, 1922, His first assignment was to the 15th Field Artillory at Port Sam Houston,

In his service as a Licutement up to 1935, General Bryan's assignments alternated between Fort Sill, Oklahema, and the U.S. Military Academy. During the feetball seasons of 1925 and 1926, he was en temperary duty as assistant football ceach at the U.S. Military Academy, and in July 1927, was appointed an instructor there. In August 1932, he entered the Field Artillery School at Fort Sill and upon graduation in May 1935, returned to an instructor post at the U.S. Military Academy. In Suptember 1933, General Bryan joined the First Field Artillery at Fort Sill, and in March 1934, returned to the U.S. Military Academy as an instructor and assistant feetball coach.

General Bryan was ordered to the Command and General Stuff School at Fort Leaverworth, Kansas, in August 1935. He was graduated in June 1936 and became an instructor at the Field Artillery School at Fort Sill. In the Fall of 1939, he entered the Army War College and was graduated in June 1940. He then was assigned toutho. G-21Section of the War Department Company Staff.

In July 1942, General Bryan was appointed Chief of the Aliens Division of the Provest Marshal General Office and in Desember of the same year, became Assistant Provest Marshal General in charge of Military Police activities and prisoners of war. In December 1945, he became the Provest Marshal General, United States Army.

Conoral Bryan was assigned to the Panama Canal Zene in June 1948 for duty as Chief of Staff of the Caribbean Command at Quarry Reights. In January 1951, during the Korean Conflict, he was assigned to command the 24th Infantry Division in Korea, and led that famous fighting unit until December 1951, when he was named Deputy Chief of Staff of the Far East Command at Tokyo, Jipan. He was appointed Commanding Conoral of the XVI Corps in Japan in November 1952, and served in that capacity until August 1953, when he became Senior Mamber of the Military Armistice Commission, United Nations Command component in Korea. The following Coteber, he assumed command of the I Corps in Korea. command of the I Corps in Korea.

In September 1954, General Bryan was appointed Superintendent of the U. S. Hilitary Academy at West Point, New York, where he served in that capacity for two years. In July 1958, General Bryan left West Point to take commend of the United States Army, Profife, located in Hawmis In that assignment, General Bryan assisted the Commender-in-Chief, Facific in planning the Satespation of the Far Est Commend with the new commend structure of the United States Perces in the Facific area.

On August 1, 1957, General Bryon assumed esemand of the First U.S. Army, at Governors Island, N.Y., and was appointed Chairman, U.S. Military Pologation, Military Staff Committee, United Mations, and Senior U.S. Army Representative of the Military Staff Committee of the United Mations.

Gonoral Bryan has been awarded the Distinguished Service Model with First Cak Leaf Cluster, Army Commendation Ribbon, the Order of the British Empire, the French Legion of Honor in the grade of Chevalier; the Columbian Order de Boyana (Gran Official) and the Mercan Order of Military Merit, Taiguk. While serving in Morea, he curied six cappaign stars and was awarded the Lir Medal. He married Cotherine De Armend on June 12, 1926. Their four children are Blecksheer Herrison III, Rebert Edward, James Edward, and Catherine Merinda.

Gonoral Bryan was promoted to First Lieutenant July 18, 1927; to Captain August 1, 1935; to Major July 1, 1940; to Lieutenant Colonel Docomber 24, 1941; to Colonel Pobruary 1, 1942; to Brigadior General Docomber 4, 1942; to Major Gonoral February 13, 1951; and to Lieutenant General January 26, 1954.

This modument was erected by the people of Queensland in grateful memory of the contribution made by the people of the U.S.A. to the defense of Australia during 1939-45 war.

Long may it stand as a symbol of unity of English speaking peoples in the cause of freedom.

The Australian-American Association initiated and implemented the erection of this memorial. The funds were raised by public appeal, launched by the Lord Mayor of Brisbane on 3 March 1950. The first sed was turned by the President of the Association on 3 May 1951 in the presence of the Premier of Queeneland and the Ambassador Extraordinary and Prime Minister Plenipotentiary of the U. S. A.


